TERMS & CONDITIONS

Entries open from Mon 20th June and close on Mon 12th September 2022 COB.

Entry into the Street Art Project is open to Western Downs Residents who are aged 13 - 18 years and live, work or study in the Western Downs region. Boarding school and home school students from the region are also eligible.

Participants, either individually or as a group can submit an entry.

The Street Art design must be submitted with an Artwork Statement (max 100 words) addressing the question 'how are public arts and culture important to your mental wellbeing?' and an Artist Statement to tell us about the artist/s (max 50 words).




All entries will be viewed by a panel of Western Downs Regional Council staff who will select a shortlist. The shortlist will be presented to and viewed by a panel of judges who will select three finalists for production of street art in their hometown. Each finalist will have a professionally produced short video incorporating the artwork and installation process of the street art. Finalist videos will be premiered, and prize money awarded to the finalists. The judge's decision is final, and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.

All suitable artwork designs will be hosted and displayed on the Western Downs Arts website and shared on Council's social media platforms to create awareness of the project. Council will, if requested, publish the art works anonymously. Artists will be notified if their work is to be included in the online display.

Artwork must be entirely the work of the entrant/s and must never have been previously published, in print or online, or have won a prize in another Art Project. Any entry found to have been plagiarised will be disqualified.

Finalists will be notified prior to publication. Finalists may be required to participate in media opportunities.





TERMS & CONDITIONS

Artists retain the copyright of their work and agree to grant Western Downs Regional Council an irrevocable nonlapsing licence to use, reproduce, and publish their artwork in a form of street art and on its website and other media, and for the use in any further relevant marketing/promotional materials for example, but not limited to, in posters and pamphlets.

Any entrant wishing to withdraw an artwork submission from the project before the closing date of Monday 12 September 2022 can do so by notifying us in writing Arts@wdrc.qld.gov.au.

UNDER 18

Entrants must have parental consent to enter, unless the entrant is already 18 years old at the time of entry. The entrant's parent or guardian warrants that the work submitted is original and does not infringe the copyright, moral rights or other rights of any third party, and that the entrant owns all rights and interests in the work submitted and they have their parent or guardian's permission to enter the competition. Failure to provide a parent or guardian's consent may deem the entry ineligible. If you are between the age of 18-19 you do not require parental consent.

Entry implies an acceptance of all the rules of the Create Your Headspace! Youth Street Art Project. Entries that fail to comply with the terms and conditions and requirements may be disqualified.

Please note: organisers reserve the right to suspend the project if an inadequate amount of entries is not received.
